Vittorio Vella, born in Gorizia in 1960, music publisher and composer. He began his activity composing for the theatre and deepening the multiple thematic sonorous diffusion of sound applied to the space. He has applied his creative abilities within ambient and electronic music and, devising sounds of extensions and architectonic space and composing various record productions in the field of advanced musical search. With the composer Marco Maria Tosolini he has created "Arcana strutture sonore", a laboratory geared towards the multistylistic research and the development of "use music".

As a composer in the theater and musical panorama, he is also a sound designer and technician of the sound and has collaborated with important installations in Italy and other foreign countries (Eugenio Allegri, Paolo Bonacelli, Vittorio Gassman, Giorgio Pressburger).

He has participated with Piermario Ciani at the Biennial of Venice 2003 with a multimedia plan viewable also on the web and his musics has been used for the occasion of the Festival of the Two worlds of Spoleto. Most recently his work in the creative field has been heading in other directions leading to the direction of videos (RAI3, Videoinstallazioni)

Since 1995 he has been responsible for musical editing of the Music Edition house, Taukay. Some of the activities of Edition House Taukay involve contemporary music, and divides its activities between record production, musical organization of events, competitions and digital prints of sheet music.

His involvement in New Music, he displayed Artistic Director of "Contemporanea", the Contemporary Music Festival organized in collaboration with the Councilorship of Culture of Udine and chief organizer of the international competition for composer "Città di Udine", one of the most important initiative in Italy.

During the past editions of the festival many important composers and musicians were involved (Giorgio Battistelli, Giovanni Bonato, Renzo Cresti, Michele dall'Ongaro, James Dashow, Jean-Luc Darbellay, Roberto Fabbriciani, Yuhi Itoh, Hans-Joachim Roedelius, Terry Riley, Marco Stroppa, Alvis Vidolin e Jesus Villa Rojo).

He is broadcast manager of Taukay Web Radio, the first italian web radio station entirely dedicated to contemporary music
